

## Front Range SABER

### US Air Force Projects in and around Colorado's Front Range

\$300 Million



The Front Range SABER is a \$300 million, 5-year IDIQ contract, which consists of new construction, design, renovations, repairs, and maintenance for seven military installations in and around the Colorado Front Range.

Task orders range in value from \$3,000 to \$2M. The Front Range SABER was awarded in October, 2010. A wide variety of task orders have been completed under this contract and have included both new construction and renovations. Most notably:

- Repair Barracks at Fort Carson, \$1M
- Replace Roofs on six buildings, \$1.4M
- Renovate Building for Wellness Center, \$1.2M
- Renovate Fairchild Hall, \$1.7M
- Repair Concrete Plaza 2B and Membrane, \$1.5M

#### Contract Highlights:

- Work completed on fully operational, high security and limited access military installations
- Work performed in secure & non-secure areas
- New construction, upgrades, and renovations
- Installation and repairs on a wide variety of buildings for HVAC, electrical, communication systems, fire alarm panels and alarm upgrades, lighting, enforced concrete pads, water meters, sump pumps, playgrounds, etc.
- Work performed at seven military installations
