NASCO's 5-year, \$50 million Georgia-Florida SATOC IDIQ contract is nearly over and has entailed a broad range of maintenance, repair, minor construction, alteration, and renovation task orders. Task orders have ranged in value from \$60,000 to over \$4.6M.

A wide variety of task orders have been completed under this contract and have included both new construction and renovations. Most notably:

- Repair Gym #5 at Fort Gordon, \$4M, Completed 2012
- Replace HVAC Building 17 at Fort Benning, \$4.1M, Completed 2010
- Water Chiller Building 101, \$2.5M, Completed 2013
- Repair Barracks at Fort Benning, \$2.9M, Completed 2012

Contract Highlights:

- Work completed on fully operational, high security and limited access military installations
- Significant repairs and upgrades at Thurmond Dam
- New construction, upgrades, and renovations
