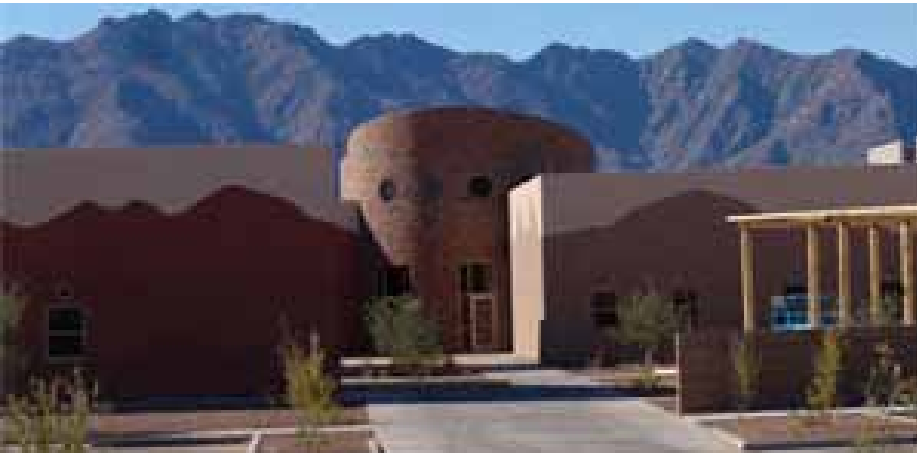

\$75 Million



This is a \$75M contract with the Department of Health and Human Services to construct various hospitals and medical facilities throughout New Mexico, Arizona, and parts of Oklahoma. The primary end-user is the Indian Health Service agency. To date, we have completed approximately \$32M in task orders, with several other large-scale projects slated for review.

Whenever agreeable by the client, we have installed energy efficient systems for long-term savings by building tenants.
